>Sing the hymns, pray and voice responses. Children learn by mimicking you.


>If you have to leave the worship space with your child, feel free to do so, but please come back. As Jesus said, "Let the children come to me."






Restrooms—located at the entrance to our worship space and in the Church Hall on the lower level.
