Readers

Servers

Servers look after many functions in the church; they carry the processional cross, processional torches, they assist in the preparation of the Altar for the Holy Eucharist, and they receive the collection.

Eucharistic Assistants

A Eucharistic Assistant is a person (youth or adult) who assists the priest in administering the sacraments of holy communion, the consecrated bread and wine. They may also take the sacraments to those who are ill, or otherwise unable to attend weekly worship.

LIFE in the EUCHARIST (L.I.T.E)

L.I.T.E. is a fun program for ages 5-9. It will give young people an opportunity to explore the mystery of the Holy Eucharist. Many parents use this program to help prepare their young people to receive First Communion.



OUTREACH

CONFIRMATION

Confirmation marks the point in the Christian journey at which you affirm for yourself the faith into which you have been baptized and your intention to live a life of committed discipleship. This affirmation is confirmed through prayer and the laying on of hands by our bishop. The Church also asks God to give you power through the Holy Spirit to enable you to live in the way of Jesus.

Our program usually begins in January and runs until May.

This program is open to young people who will be age 11 and up at the time of Confirmation (May or June).

Our Confirmation program is called *re:form* and is a totally new approach to youth ministry that trusts youth to wrestle with the historic Christian faith and theology. Each session has a short DVD presentation, discussion, activities and lots of fun.

CHURCH LADS' BRIGADE (C.L.B.)

The C.L.B. (Church Lads' Brigade) is a youth organization open to boys and girls and members of all faiths and backgrounds.

It's motto is to "Fight The Good Fight" which is based on St. Paul's Epistle to The Ephesians Chapter VI, verses 10 to 20.

The CLB is divided into five age groups:

Officers - ages 19 +

Senior Corps (SC) - grade 8 - 12

Junior Training Corps (JTC) - grades 5 - 7

Young Training Corps (YTC) - grades 2 - 4

Little Training Corps (LTC) - grades K - 1
